WHAT IS IT?

motive8 extra-curricular provision offers children a range of sports and activities which are run as breakfast, lunch or after-school clubs. Sports include gymnastics, cheerleading, netball, tag rugby and basketball alongside other activities such as skipping and mini-sports. The objective of this provision is to get children involved in regular physical activity as well as improving their sporting skills and ability.

By offering a range of activities and a 1:15 coach to child ratio, we can cater for all children – talented pupils can further enhance their sporting skills, whilst those who may be less confident in their ability can receive targeted training from our coaches to help them become more involved.

Close attention has been paid to the progression of all motive8 clubs and provision of an end focus, whether it is an official NGB award, motive8 award, match or display.

HOW IS IT DELIVERED?

All extra-curricular sessions are led by experienced motive8 coaches who, aside from all being qualified by sporting national governing bodies, have a high standard of personal sporting experience. All staff are CRB-checked and first aid trained as well as attending regular training both within the motive8 coach development programme and in their own specific sports. In addition, we maintain our low coach to child ratios to ensure children receive proper attention.
